She always said everyone cheated and when she did win, she would get a "stupid chocolate bar". She kept all the staff on their toes and the nick name she was given was "TROUBLE".

Mom was known for her feistiness, toughness, and her infectious giggle. She was kindhearted, generous, and always there when her family needed her. Her giant heart touched the lives of everyone that knew her, and all are grateful to have had her in their lives.
