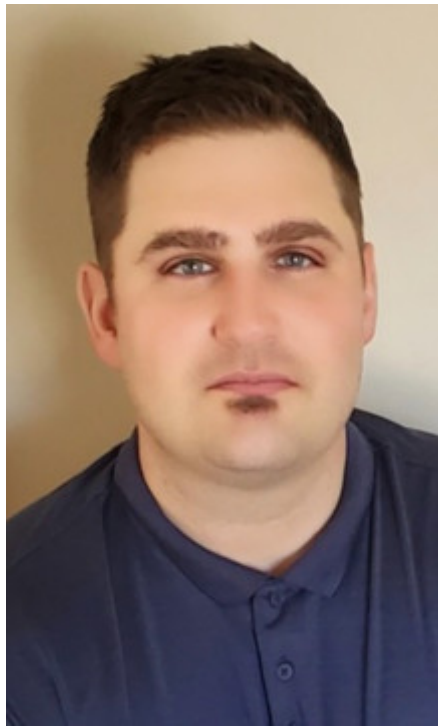


Blanchard, Michael
