Our beloved wife, mother, and grandmother, Victoria “Vicki” Marcelle Bode (née: Ingram) passed away peacefully on Sunday, March 26th, 2023 at the Dr. F.H. Wigmore Hospital in Moose Jaw, SK.

Vicki was born September 3rd, 1940 in Weyburn, SK to James and Margaret Ingram. She and her younger sister, Louise, grew up in Weyburn, SK and as a young adult, Vicki’s love of travel began with a move to Hawaii for a year. She was drawn back to the prairies and worked at the Canada Agriculture Research Centre in Swift Current, SK. She met Frank in Swift Current, and they were married in Weyburn. They would have celebrated their 60th anniversary this December.
