Ernest Henry Bueckert was born on December 12th, 1934 at Parkerview, SK. He was the fifth child of ten, born to David and Susanna Bueckert. His family moved to Tugaske, SK and later to Eyebrow, SK where he lived until moving to Bethany Place in 2005/06. Ernie attended schools in Winfield, Darmoody and Eyebrow, SK where he graduated, and later attended Rosthern Junior College (RJC) Bible School and Swift Current Bible Institute (SCBI).

On July 27th, 2025 Ernie went into St Paul's Hospital in Saskatoon, SK where he was diagnosed with cancer. He passed away at 90 years old, at peace and ready to be with his Lord, on

Monday, August 18th, 2025.

Ernie was baptized in the Eyebrow Mennonite Church where he was a member until his passing. He also served as an usher at Bethany Manor.

Ernie farmed on the family farm which was his pride and joy. He had a mixed farm until he retired in 2015.

He was predeceased by his parents, David and Susanna Bueckert; brothers: John, Abe, and David; sister, Annie; sisters-in-law: Erna Bueckert, Margaret Bueckert, Kay Bueckert, and Sadie Bueckert.
