Born in D'Arcy, Saskatchewan, Carol was raised on the farm near Brock, Saskatchewan with seven siblings. She met Ken, the love of her life, in Moose Jaw in 1964. They married in 1965 and raised three daughters.

Carol worked for the Western Development Museum at reception.

She categorized the museum inventory inserting factual information on all the pieces, which is still in use today.

In 1980, Carol and Ken opened the family business of Centennial Tire Centre Ltd. Carol served the Moose Jaw community as an owner and bookkeeper for 29 years. She sponsored numerous local sports teams and community events. Carol was the heart of the business and spent hours talking with and caring for customers.

Carol was always working on projects. She spent hours collecting and tweaking recipes, crocheting, gardening, quilting, petit pointing and numerous other crafts. She was an amazing cook and loved hosting friends and family. Her home was always warm and welcoming. Carol loved to travel and see new places. Spending time with family was one of Carol's greatest joys.
