With great sadness we announce the passing of **William “Bill” Everett Chase** on Friday, October 19th, 2018 at the Dr. F.H. Wigmore Regional Hospital in Moose Jaw, SK due to complications after a brief illness. He was predeceased by his father, Alvin “Acel”; mother, Alma; son, Darren; siblings: Ilene, Florence, Orin “Bud”, and Frances; half-siblings: Evelyn, Harland, and Wilfred; and step-daughter-in-law, Barb. Bill will be forever missed by his loving wife of 30 years, Marlene; children: Kevyn (Zoe), Heather (Daniel) and (Cheryl); step-children, Jim and Karen (Ken); siblings, Gladys and Ernie (Susan); grandchildren: Jean-Paul (Renée), Alyssa (Craig), Alexis (Jeff), and Thea; step-grandchildren, Tom (Muriel) and Jenna (Dennis); great-grandchildren, Emily and Ziyah; and step-great-grandchildren: Noah, Isaac and Erin.
