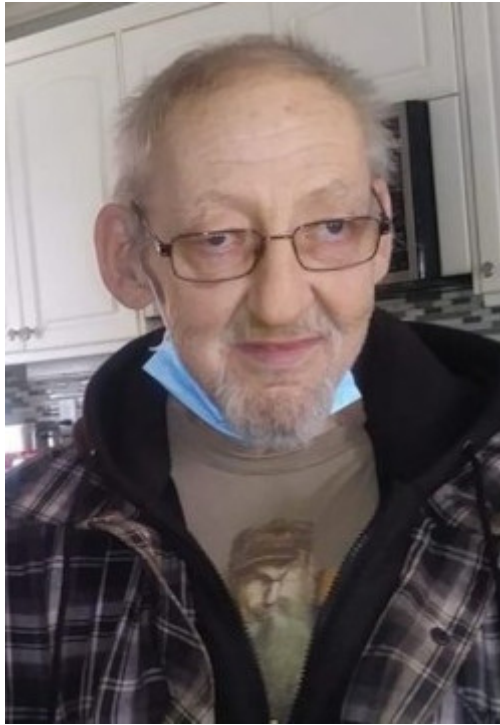


Chubb, Bill (Wilfred)
