Isabelle passed away peacefully on Saturday, October 13th, 2018 at the age of 94 years. Isabelle was born on May 28th, 1924 in South Norwich, ON to Alexander and Margaret Sinclair during the time of her parent's journey from Wick, Scotland to Ponteix, SK.

Isabelle spent the majority of her childhood in Ponteix and then Swift Current, SK. Upon graduation from High School she relocated to Moose Jaw to undertake the Nursing Program at the Moose Jaw General Hospital. She graduated as a Registered Nurse in 1947 and from that time forward she continued in the nursing profession until her retirement in 1991. Isabelle is survived by her sons: **Douglas** (Camillia), **Rob** (Glennis), **Dean** (Barbara), and **Gary**; seven grandchildren, six great-grandchildren, and one great-great-grandchild. She is also survived by one brother-in-law, Cork Peden of Calgary, AB; and numerous nieces and nephews.
