On the morning of Wednesday, April 10th, 2013, Euclid (Eucie) Closs passed away peacefully at the age of 88 years. The Memorial Service to Celebrate Eucie's Life will be held on Wednesday, April 17th, 2013 at 2:00 p.m. in St. Joseph's Roman Catholic Church, 1064 3rd Ave. N.W. Moose Jaw, SK. Eucie was born June 24th, 1924 at St. Boswells, Saskatchewan. Eucie served overseas in the Second World War as a member of the Regina Rifles. After the war, Eucie met Dorothy Wellsch. Eucie worked at Blackwood's Hardware and later retired from Scott Ford where he worked as Sales Manager for several years. Dad was a natural athlete. After retirement, Eucie and Dorothy spent many summers at their condo in Elbow where they both enjoyed golf and Dad loved to fish. Both he and Dorothy were very active with the church, serving as lay ministers and as members of the church choir for several years.
