In the early morning hours of Monday October 31st, 2016, Florence Mary Cowie passed away peacefully at Moose Jaw Pioneer Lodge following a short illness. She was 100 years old. In 1934 Florence met Ronald Cowie and they were subsequently married on March 10th, 1937. Together they raised three children, and farmed in the Mankota district for twenty-nine years. They then sold their farm and moved to Moose Jaw to retire. After Ronald passed on in 2000, and a brief stay in a condominium near Crescent Park, Florence was forced by impending blindness to move to a suite in the Mulberry Estates in Moose Jaw where she spent the remaining thirteen and a half years of her life.
