Regardless, a love story ensued. Maria and Antonio lived, worked, and of course raised their family, side by side for the rest of their lives. They even retired together while both were working at St. Margaret's School.

Although tiny in stature, Maria's presence filled the room with her boundless energy, bright eyes, and benevolent spirit.
