It is with great sadness that we announce the passing of Joseph Delawski on Friday, August 21st, 2026, at the age of 76 years.

Joe was born to Mike and Olga Delawski and was raised on the family farm west of Rockford, SK. At the age of 16, he went out working, first in Saskatoon, SK and then in Calgary, AB. On March 28th, 1970, he married Judy Halbach. In 1972, they moved back from Calgary to farm south of Lintlaw, SK, where they raised their family. In addition to the farming he loved, he spent many enjoyable hours in his shop, fixing his own farm machinery and that of others in the community.

After 40 years of farming, Joe's health dictated his retirement, and they moved to Moose Jaw, SK to be near their grandchildren, where he filled the rest of his time with his second love – fishing. Over the years, Joe and Judy enjoyed many road trips in Canada and the Western USA, Alaska, as well as two trips to
