It is with love and sadness that the family of Lorraine Darlene Dixon announces her peaceful passing on Tuesday, September 30th, 2025, just three days before her 87th birthday.

Born in Lafleche, Saskatchewan, Lorraine grew up surrounded by the warmth of a close-knit prairie community. She attended school in Lafleche before pursuing higher education at the University of Saskatchewan, where she earned her education degree, majoring in Home Economics – a field that reflected her lifelong passions.

In 1961, Lorraine married the love of her life, James (Jim) Dixon. Together, they built a life centered on family,

education, and community. Lorraine worked as a dedicated home economics teacher at Central Collegiate, where she inspired generations of students with both her knowledge and her compassion.
