Shirley Jean Ewen (née: Hall) passed away peacefully on Monday, June 17th, 2024, at the Central Butte Regency Manor at the age of 89 years. Shirley, daughter of Charles and Annie Hall, was born September 6th, 1934, in Lucky Lake, SK. She was the 9th of 10 children and attended primary school in Sunkist, SK and finished school in Lucky Lake.

Shirley married Art Ewen on October 24th, 1953, in Lucky Lake, SK. They farmed north of Riverhurst, SK until moving to town in 1980.

Shirley enjoyed entertaining, dancing and was very musical. She played the organ, sang in the United Church Choir, and

volunteered singing at Regency Manor. She was a member of the Rebecca Lodge, taught Sunday school, volunteered with the Ladies Auxiliary and the Riverhurst Tourism Committee.
