Lorraine Ida Fenwick, aged 90 years of Moose Jaw, SK, passed away peacefully on Thursday, May 15th, 2014 after a brief illness. She was predeceased by her parents, Edward and Zelda Thomson; her husband, Oliver and brother, Len.
