In 2010, one of Wendy's greatest loves came into her life, her dog Charlie. Charlie rarely left Wendy's side and would lay under her machine while she quilted, just to be close to her.

Her family can attest that she faced the last difficult months of her life with a sense of humor, grace, unwavering strength and stubbornness. Wendy was a true gem and will be sadly missed.
