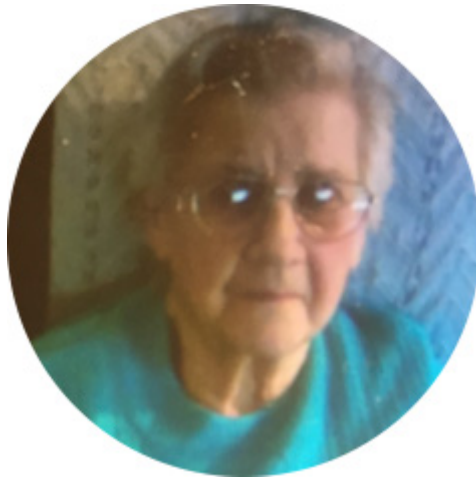


# Fjaagesund, Pearl Elizabeth
