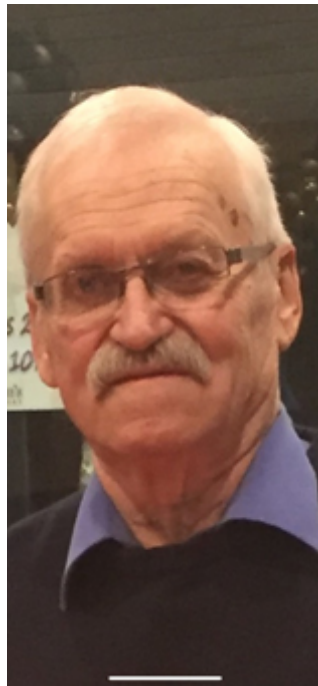


Folk, Norman (Norm) John
