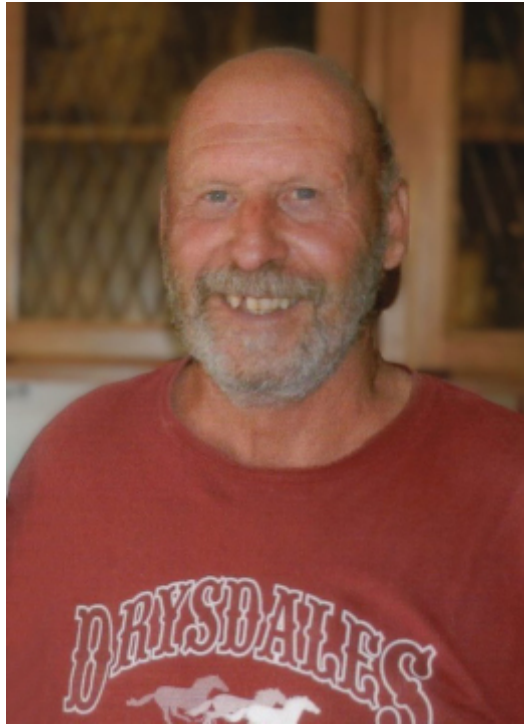


Fox, Lloyd George

It is with great sadness that we announce the passing of Lloyd George Fox, aged 77 years of Moose Jaw, SK, on Tuesday, July 9th, 2024. Lloyd was born in Moose Jaw on October 13th, 1946. After high school, Lloyd worked at Scott National in the warehouse, at Western Grocers, and then later in life he delivered fuel for the Co-op. But his true passion was raising cattle. He loved the farm and spent his days feeding and checking on the cows, calving, branding, and everything a farmer loves to do.

Lloyd met the love of his life, Sylvia, in 1966 when they were both working at Scott National. They were married in 1968 and spent the next 56 years enjoying life together. They played

baseball, loved going to dances together, spending time with friends, and being part of a close community of neighbors.
