Walter is survived by six sisters Helen, Kay, Marge, Betty, Delores and Marlene; three brothers Joseph, David and Eddy. He leaves to mourn his wife Emily; three sons Randy (Lil), Boyd and Reg; one daughter Candace (Rod) and six beautiful grandchildren. Walter farmed for many years on the family farm near Bridgeford and retired in Central Butte. Dad loved cards, especially bridge which he played so often, as well as cribbage and solitaire. He enjoyed fishing and hunting and was a past president of the local Central Butte Wildlife Federation. He spent many a winter curling and loved to watch the game when he was no longer able to curl himself. The last four years he became very limited with being on kidney dialysis in Moose Jaw but never complained and accepted this challenge by facing it head on.
