Allan “Bear” Leslie Gill, aged 63 years of Moose Jaw, SK passed away peacefully on Tuesday, November 27th, 2018 surrounded by family and friends. Allan was born in February 1955 and enjoyed life on the farm in Pasqua, SK before moving to Moose Jaw, SK, with his family. He attended school at Lindale, Ross, and Peacock Collegiate in Moose Jaw before joining the Moose Jaw School Division, where he worked as a caretaker for 42 years.
