With deeply broken hearts, we announce the sudden passing of Leslee “Robyn” Grigg of Moose Jaw, SK on Friday July 12th, 2024, at the age of 67 years. She was born to Karol (née: Sisson) and George Grigg on January 1st, 1957, in Moose Jaw.

Robyn received her education in Moose Jaw and attended the University of Saskatchewan, obtaining her Education Degree. In 2000, she completed her master’s degree from the San Diego State University and retired in 2015 from A. E. Peacock School.

One of the strongest passions in Robyn’s life was the love of travel. Her desire to experience new and interesting cultures and cuisines has taken her to numerous countries around the world. Her favorite destination was Thailand. Another passion was the family farm, which she became a part of in 1989. Robyn
