**Joyce Hart** passed away peacefully in Moose Jaw, SK on Sunday, April 26th, 2020 at the age of 84 years. Joyce was born at home in Rossburn, MB and grew up on the family farm. Joyce and Don were married in 1958 and her wedding day was one of the happiest moments of her life.
