She was born with only three chambers in her heart (Hypoplastic Left Heart Syndrome). At 4 days old Kayla was transferred to Saskatoon hospital. At 8 days old she was flown to Philadelphia for the first heart surgery. At 12 months she would have another surgery in Philadelphia and then again at 18 months old Kayla would return to Philadelphia for open heart surgery. Each surgery was successful in giving Kayla a better quality of life. Kayla would spend the next 35 years fighting everyday of her life and living life to the

absolute fullest.

Kayla will be remembered for her love for life. Kayla's life revolved around her family and friends. Kayla's friends became part of our family. If you knew Kayla, she was unapologetically herself and lived life on her terms. Kayla had a love for horror movies. Especially Chucky. But most of all Kayla's love for her family was everything.
