When Ron finished school, he came to Moose Jaw, SK to work at CP Rail and later at the Moose Jaw Union Hospital. It was while he worked at the hospital that he met Jean Memory. They were married on October 8th, 1960 and were blessed with two children, Barry and Robin.

Later, Ron became a Service Manager at Western Dodge in Moose Jaw. In 1961 he began employment with Trans Canada Pipelines at Caron, SK and in 1990 became the Maintenance Planner at the office in Regina, SK, where he remained until his retirement in

1999.
