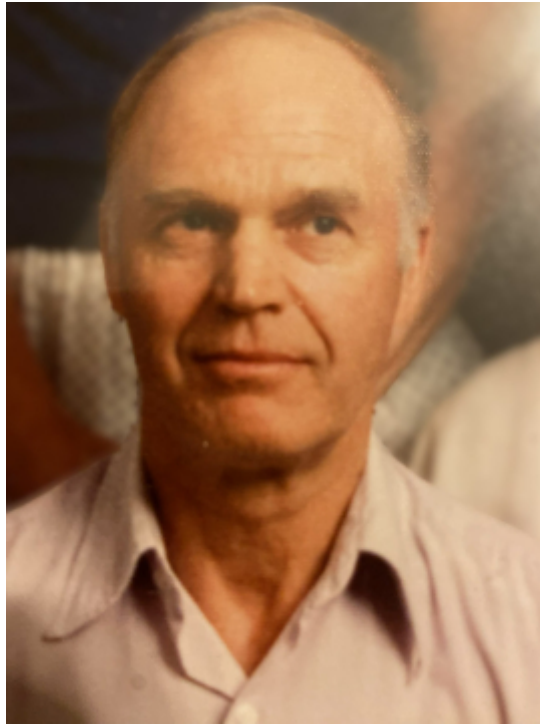


Hayward, Robert George
