Anne Emily Heron (Lockert) passed away on Tuesday, October 2nd, 2018 at the age of 95 years. Anne was born on January 31st, 1923 at Vibank, SK. The family moved to Portland, Oregon, then later to Denzel, SK. Mom completed all her schooling at Denzel, then attended Normal School in Moose Jaw in 1942. She taught school at West Lake from 1943-1944. She married Alvin Heron in 1944 and farmed at Marquis for 23 years before moving to Moose Jaw in 1967. Mom worked at the Union Hospital as a ward clerk for 20 years. After retiring mom volunteered at the Union Hospital gift shop and Parson's Pantry at St. Andrew's Church.

She was predeceased by her husband Alvin in 1970 and grandson in 1974, her parents Rosena and Casimir Lockhart; brothers, Mike, Casy, Ed, George, Tom, and Larry and sisters, Betty, Sister Patricia and Kaye.
