Aage Jensen passed away on Sunday, May 5th, 2024, in Moose Jaw, SK. Aage was born on May 15th, 1929, in his childhood home in Vinding, Denmark; immigrated to Alberta in 1957; and came to Moose Jaw in 1958. He served one year in the Royal Danish Army and received his education and trades training in Denmark. He belonged to the International Union of Bricklayers and Allied Craftworkers Local 1 and was a member of St. Barnabas Anglican Church. Aage was employed as a bricklayer and stonemason by Moose Jaw and Regina area contractors, having worked on many prominent buildings. His hobbies included leather tooling, gardening, woodworking, fishing, wine and beer making, computers, and even crafted his own telescopes. Aage can best be described as extremely patient, levelheaded, a continuous learner, and had the ability to adapt to whatever life threw his
