Mona Eleanor Jones (Cooper) of Moose Jaw, passed away peacefully on October 7th, 2016 at the age of 101. Mona was born in Moose Jaw, the youngest of a family of 7 children. She graduated in the first graduating class of Peacock Collegiate as a bookkeeper/stenographer. She managed both the Kresgee's and Eaton's lunch counters before leaving for Vancouver in 1942. There she worked as a bookkeeper until she came home to Moose Jaw to be married to Ronald Jones in November of 1945. Together they raised 2 children (Ray and Gayle). Mona went back to work in the office at Eatons in the early 1960s and retired 15 years later. Mona was a very positive person who enjoyed life to the full. Her cheerful personality was infectious. In her younger years Mona was an active member of the Canadian Girl Guides and made many lasting friendships. At the age of 97 she rejoined the organization as a member of the Trefoil Guides, actively participating and making many more friends. Mona loved gardening and doing handicrafts.
