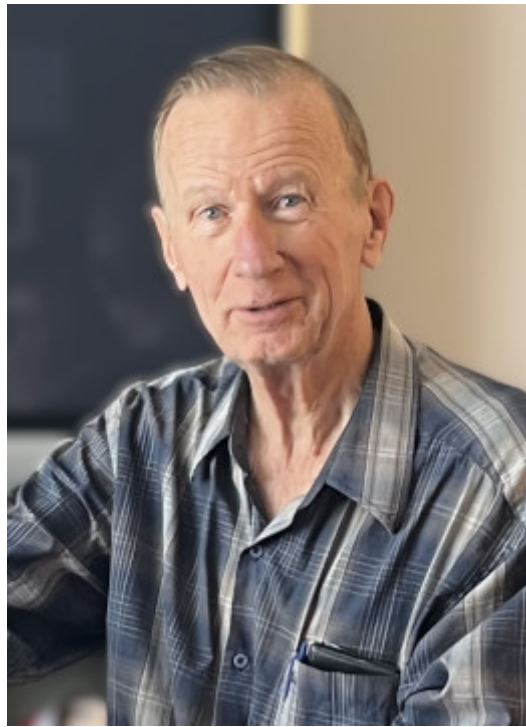


Kemp, Gary
