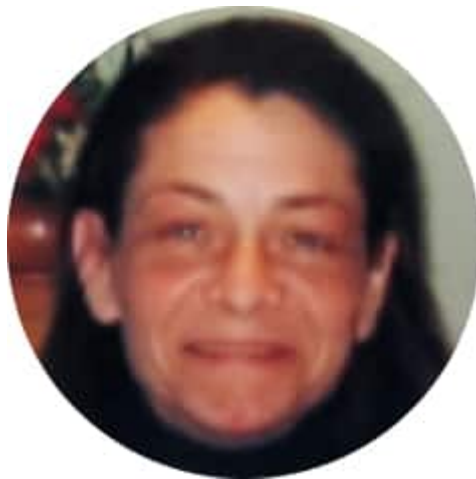


Kindrat, Teresa
