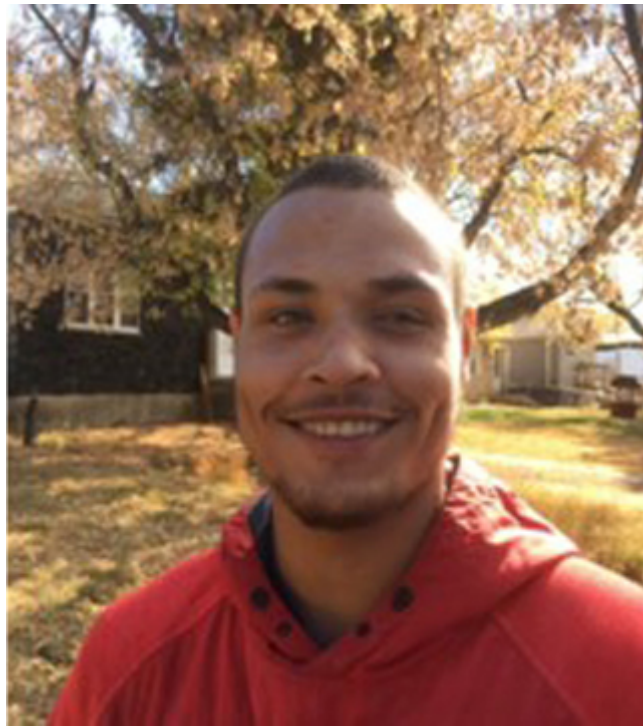


Kormish, James Joseph Payne

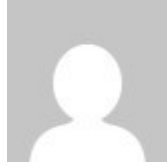
