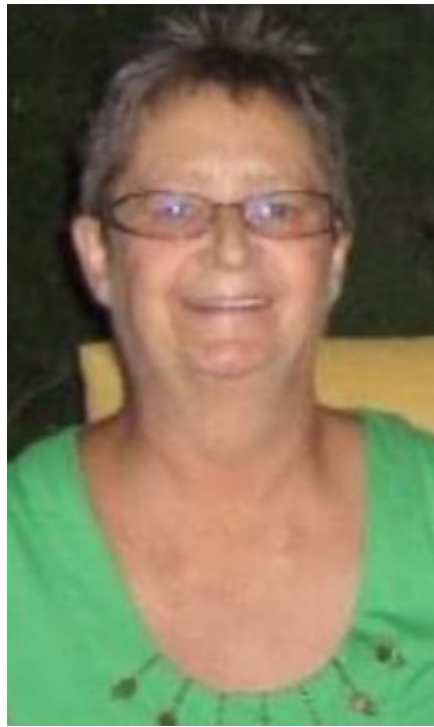


LaLonde, Linda

The co-workers from Service Canada became life-long friends for which her family is forever grateful. Linda downsized from her large home to Temple Towers in January 2023, where she quickly made new friends and took part in nickel bingo and other social events organized in the building. Linda was an avid crafter, from needlepoint to crochet, photography, gardening, card making and scrapbooking. Scrapbooking was where Linda met and developed more life-long friendships.
