Dorothy Louise Lang passed away on Monday, November 2nd, 2020. Dorothy's favorite story was when she was 8 years old and she had to go to the convent in Holdfast, SK in the summertime for catechism. One day one of the girls told her she had a baby brother. The next morning she got up at 5 o'clock, packed her suitcase and walked home, which was 8 miles away. She walked into the yard and her dad had the horse hooked up to the wagon. He put her in the wagon and took her back to Holdfast. My understanding is that she never even got to see little Albert.

Mom, we can only imagine what it will be like when your wing man (Dad) is waiting with his arms out for you. You have been the heart of our family and you are finally at peace.
