With heavy hearts, we announce that Orville Wayne Leugner passed away peacefully at home in his chair on Monday, October 6th, 2025, at the age of 83 years, surrounded by the people who loved him most – his family. Orville also had a deep love for music, dancing, and the occasional jam session – especially if it meant pulling out the guitar or tapping a toe to an old tune. He never met a stranger that he couldn't talk to, and if you had a few minutes (or a few hours), he was more than happy to chat – whether it was over coffee or a cigarette.

Orville was known for his signature salute, a cheeky middle finger that he used as a greeting or a see you later. He had a one-of-a-kind sense of humor, a heart of gold, and could get away with saying things that no one else could. Orville was admired, respected, and loved by many. He leaves behind a legacy of family, friends, laughter and stories that only comes from living a life well lived.
