LORNE LINDQUIST March 24th, 1923 – February 4th, 2013

Lorne Albert Lindquist, aged 89 years of Moose Jaw and formerly of Chaplin, SK, passed away on Monday, February 4th, 2013. Lorne was born March 24th, 1923 near Valjean, SK.
