## Florence Clara MacDonald

Florence Clara MacDonald passed away peacefully with a dear friend Bonnie Binner at her side, on Thursday, February 26th, 2009. The Funeral Service will be held on Friday, March 6th, 2009 at 2:00 p.m. in Moose Jaw Funeral Home Chapel. Rev. John Carley will officiate and burial will take place at Mossbank Cemetery at a later date. Florence was born on March 24th, 1905 in Blaengariw, Wales to James and Louisa Tattershall.
