Jacob Emmanuel, age 95 years of Moose Jaw, Sk., passed away on Friday, August 31st, 2012 at Moose Jaw Union Hospital. Jacob was born to Adolf Rudolf Maier and Amalia Julia Maier(nee Nagel), he was born the eighth child of fourteen children on April 3rd , 1917 in Balgonie, Sk. Jacob was raised on a farm near Bayard, Sk., where he married Eileen Cora Thieson on April 3rd, 1945.
