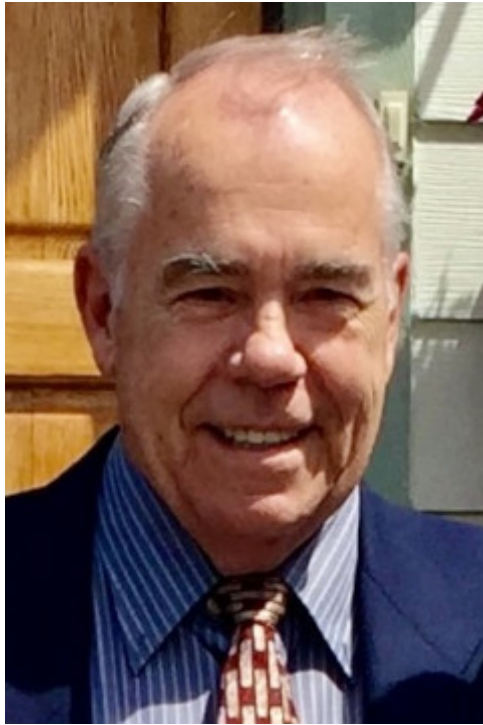


McCormick, Daniel Joseph George
