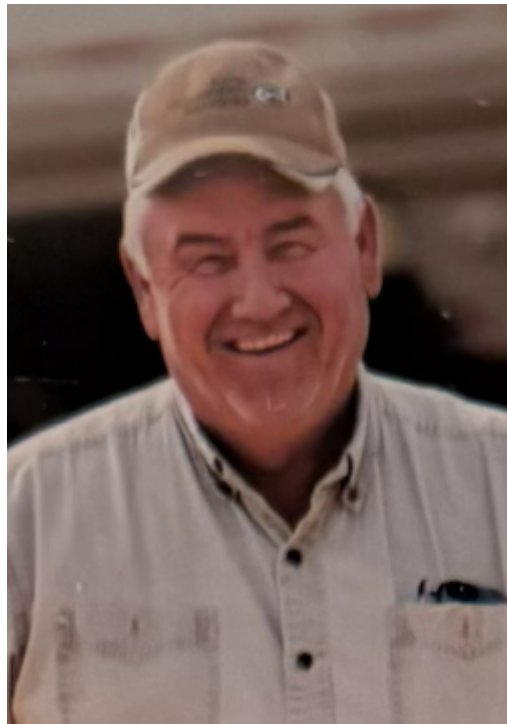

Ronald Gordon McDonald, born June 12th, 1958 in Moose Jaw, SK, passed away on Monday, December 15th, 2025, surrounded by the love of his family.
