Marsha Carole McFarlane, aged 64 years of Moose Jaw, SK passed away on Saturday, September 22nd, 2018 at the Dr. F.H. Wigmore Regional Hospital in Moose Jaw, SK. Born in 1953 in Herbert, SK, she was predeceased by her parents, Melvin and Florence Biggs; grandparents: Rosie and Amos Biggs, and Robert and Nora Polley; and niece, Cindy Perry. Marsha attended Morse High School before moving to Calgary, AB for a short time to pursue classes towards becoming a veterinary assistant. She was an active member in her community serving as the Director of the Moose Jaw Humane Society for 10 years, and operator of a care home with Community Living for the last 20 years. In early motherhood she enjoyed decorating cakes, making doll clothing, and sewing clothes for her children. For many years leading up to her passing, she was an avid player of online poker, winning her fair share of jackpots. Marsha loved

to support and watch Telemiracle with her clients and family, and she was a dedicated curling fan. Despite her hectic schedule, family and friends were Marsha's passion and delight.
