Dale Herbert McKechnie of Edmonton, Alberta passed away Monday, February 27th, 2023 in Playa Del Carmen, Mexico. **A Celebration of Dale's Life will be held on Sunday, June 25th, 2023 from 1:00 p.m. – 4:00 p.m. at the Eagles Club, 561 Home St W, Moose Jaw, SK.**

Dale was born in Moose Jaw, SK on April 7th, 1959 and lived in Moose Jaw with his parents Dorothy and Stanley and 11 siblings. Dale started his career in the trades with his brother Dave working for Moose Jaw Plumbing and Heating in 1980. He continued his career as a plumber/fitter and would receive his journeyman ticket in 1995. In 2000 he moved to Edmonton and pursued his career as a pipefitter with the Alberta Local 488 pipe trades. In 2020 he received his 30 year recipient's plaque for his dedication to his union and his trade. He worked on

many large projects throughout his career including the Co-op upgrader in Regina, the Husky upgrader in Lloydminster, Shell Scottford in Ft. Saskatchewan, and Albian Sands in Ft. McMurray.
