M. Lillian McLafferty, aged 95 years of Moose Jaw, SK., passed away October 19th, 2010. A Funeral Mass will be celebrated on Saturday, October 23rd, 2010 at 2:00 p.m. in Church Of Our Lady, 566 Vaughan St., Moose Jaw, SK. Father Carlos Jimenez will be the presiding celebrant and burial of cremains will follow at Rosedale Cemetery.
