It is with sadness we announce the passing of **George Sutherland Donn Miller** on Saturday, January 11th, 2020 at the age of 94 years. He was predeceased by his wife, Jeanne Miller; parents, Lillian and George Miller; and sister, Muriel Miller. George will be lovingly remembered by his son, **George** (Kathryn) Miller; daughter, **Beverley** Miller; grandchildren, George (Elizabeth) Miller of Toronto, ON and Sarah Miller of Regina, SK; great-grandson, Geordie Miller of Toronto, ON; sisters-in-law: Carol Balon, Millie Scott, and Marion Balon; along with numerous nieces and nephews. George was born in Melville, SK and then moved to Regina. At nineteen he enlisted with the Royal Canadian Navy and served on HMCS Puncher from 1943-1945. George's retirement years were spent living at Buena Vista, SK until 2014 when he moved to Moose Jaw, residing at the Caleb Village.
