It is with heavy hearts and profound sadness we announce that Darrel Wayne Molde, aged 69 years of Parkbeg, Saskatchewan, passed away peacefully on Monday, March 23rd, 2026, with his beloved family by his side.

Darrel lived a life rooted in community, family, and the land he loved. A lifelong farmer, he found true joy and purpose in his work, dedicating himself to agriculture with passion and pride. Farming was not just his livelihood it was who he was.

Darrel was a proud member of the Parkland Kinsmen for many years and served his community as a councillor for the RM of Wheatlands, always willing to lend a hand and give back to those
