With sadness we announce that **George Murray Cruden Morrison**, aged 96 years of Moose Jaw, SK passed away peacefully on Thursday, January 9th, 2020 at Extendicare, with family by his side. He was predeceased by his parents, William and Isabella; wife, Muriel; and brothers: Bill, John and Alex. George is survived by his daughter, **Glenys** (Ron) Rollie; son, **Derek** (Valerie); grandchildren: Michelle (Aaron) Welsh, Shawn (Karla) Rollie, Haig (Momoko) Morrison, and Keegan (Joyce) Morrison; and great-grandchildren: Clarissa, Tyler, Emily, Cheyanne, Camryn and Megan. George was born in Rouleau, Saskatchewan. In 1936, at age 13, he returned to Scotland with his parents. At age 17 he began work as a mechanic in Ellon, Aberdeenshire. In 1964 the family immigrated to Moose Jaw and George began work as a mechanic. In 1975 he and his partner, Jim Charters, opened Palliser Service on Caribou Street West. George had many interests; he was a

member of the Kiwanis Club, was one of the founding members of the Scottish Society, was an ardent volunteer at MOTIF, and loved to dance.
