It is with great sadness that we announce the passing of Lewis (Lew) Murphy on October 12th, 2011 with his wife of 63 years by his side. Lew was born in Krydor, SK on November 15th, 1925. He moved to Moose Jaw in 1929. He began his career with the CPR in 1943 working first as a wiper, then a fireman and finally as an engineer before retiring in 1985. Shortly after starting with the CPR he joined the Navy. His ship – the Trentonian – was the last corvette sunk in World War II. While at home awaiting assignment to a new ship, the war ended therefore he returned to his job at the CPR. In November 1945 he met Marion Genevieve Maloney – the love of his life, and they were married on his birthday – November 15th, 1947. They raised 6 children together. He was passionate about his hobby of 25 years – raising, training and racing his standard bred horses. After retiring, Lew and Marion enjoyed two wonderful trips to Ireland. Lew will be lovingly remembered by his wife, Marion; his children, Anne (John) Holman – Lumsden, Pat (Joan) Murphy – Moose Jaw, Mary Ellen Sleightholme – Vancouver, Tom (Hazel) Murphy – Cranbrook, Sharon Cawsey – Des Moines, Washington,
