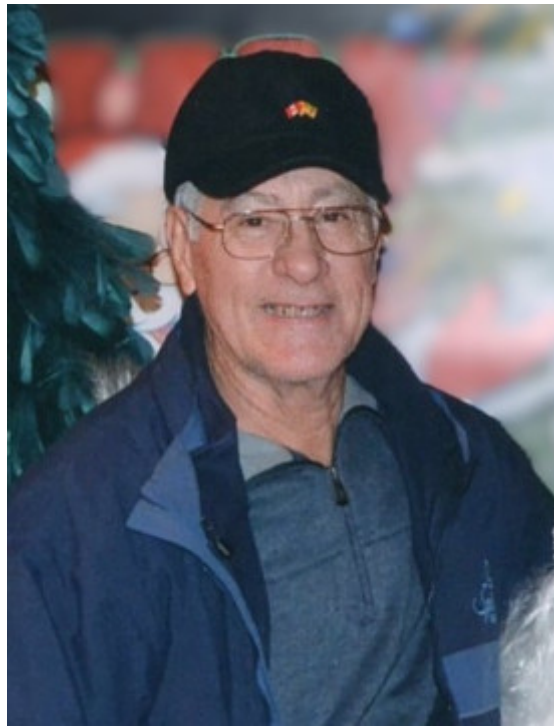


Norman, John Kenneth (Ken)

It is with sadness that we announce the passing of a great person, **John Kenneth (Ken) Norman**. Ken passed away peacefully at Providence Place in Moose Jaw, SK on Tuesday, June 11th, 2024, at the age of 86 years after a long period of declining health. **A Memorial Service will be held in the Harvey Room at Moose Jaw Funeral Home on Saturday, June 22nd, 2024 at 1:00 p.m. to share memories and to celebrate Ken's life.
