With heavy hearts, we announce the death of **Clarice Marie Oxley**, a beloved wife, mother, grandmother and great grandmother at the age of 82 on Tuesday, August 24th, 2021. She passed away due to heart complications with her family at her side. She was just a week away from a potential new lease on life through a scheduled medical procedure.
