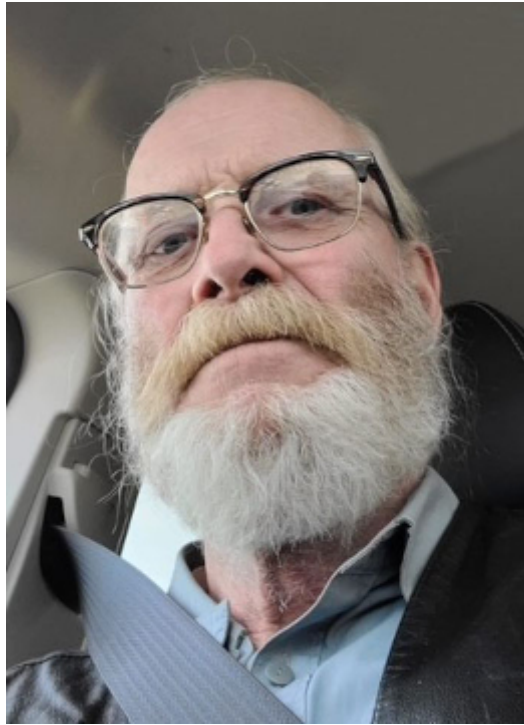


Peden, Robert (Bob)

The family of Robert (Bob) Peden are saddened to announce his passing at home on Wednesday, March 11th, 2026. Bob was born in Winnipeg, Manitoba on December 19th, 1957 to Jack and Dora Peden. He was the younger brother to Don and Ruth.

The Peden family moved to Moose Jaw, SK in the late 50's and that is where Bob grew up. He attended the U of R where he obtained a BA and a Teacher's Certificate. While there he was the President of the Student's Union and was involved with making "The Owl" happen.
